CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Tyler Freres at 9:01 a.m.

Chair Freres welcomed new board member, Jon Irvine, as the employee representative.

OLD BUSINESS

Executive Director Isselmann requested rescheduling the July 24 board meeting to July 23 due to a scheduling conflict. A poll will be sent to board members to check availability.

Executive Director Isselmann reported on the impacts to OFRI programs as a result of COVID-19:

- May 1 Envirothon is canceled. Staff is developing an online testing and video contest.
- Outdoor School Pilot at the Oregon Garden has not been canceled to date, however, staff is monitoring the situation closely.
- Schools are rapidly canceling the Oregon Garden NREC program.
- Staff is proposing to postpone the June 12 board tour in Tillamook to the fall.

ITEMS FROM BOARD MEMBERS

Jon Irvine is working with the Governor's office to assist employers with layoffs.
