Scope and methodology summary: The audit covers OFRI's purpose and strategic direction, organizational structure and program functions, approach to public messaging, and stakeholder relationships and staff activities. The Secretary of State team will review and assess relevant statutory and legislative materials, OFRI's strategic and policy documents, OFRI advertisements and summary reports, materials provided in the public records request, and criteria outlining good governance standards. The Secretary of State team will also conduct further fieldwork interviews with agency staff, relevant stakeholders and comparative programs to learn more about their purpose, functions and practices.
